- We'll have two throwers, one spring-loaded and one electric, courtesy of Capt. Dan Affalter. If you want a fancy gun range, go to a gun club. This is not an Olympic qualifier.
- We have 12 ga. shotguns and one .410 for anyone to use. You are welcome to bring your own gun. Immediately after the shoot, you will be asked to lock your gun in the trunk of your car. If you don't own a gun and you just want to try it, please come on out and have a good time. We'll do our best to give everyone a chance.
- You are encouraged to bring your own shells. We'll have shells available at whatever cost is incurred at Wal-Mart until we run out. They will be cheap target loads, so if you're worried about gumming up your priceless gun, you're welcome to bring your own.
- We'll provide some foam ear plugs, but if you have ear protection, please bring it. Some of us don't hear very well on a good day and ear protection is vital.
- This is just for fun and anyone taking it too seriously (except for safety rules) will be required to do push-ups or run laps.
